

Theta Delts in Madison

From August 5th-8th, Theta Delts from around North America converged on Madison, WI to celebrate the 162nd Convention of our Fraternity. Home of the Sigma Deuteron Charge at the University of Wisconsin, Madison proved to be the ideal location to renew our fraternal bonds while celebrating the resurgence of a Charge that has remained in continuous existence at UW since 1895. While many of our attendees had never been to Madison or the state of Wisconsin before, everyone left with a great opinion of the venue as an action packed week certainly showcased many of the wonderful things the city had to offer. Located between two beautiful lakes, Madison is not just the large state university campus with which many associate it, but also serves

as the state capital and cultural center of Wisconsin. Most of our attendees stayed at The Edgewater, a historic hotel right on the banks of Lake Mendota. When they weren't busy with the many Convention events or sampling the variety of establishments on State Street, brothers were able to relax on the dock of The Edgewater and enjoy the nearly perfect weather that Madison provided for us throughout the week of Convention.

Brothers first met at the Sigma Deuteron Charge house on Wednesday evening to reconnect with old friends and make new ones before we split off for a casual evening at in Madison. Most of the alumni departed for a very quaint dinner at Porta Bella restaurant

while the undergraduates spent the evening at State Street Brats enjoying some traditional Wisconsin fare. On Thursday, the Convention reconvened for the annual meeting of Theta Delta Chi right on the University of Wisconsin's campus. This very productive meeting was followed shortly by the annual Omega Service, a non-denominational service which honors those brothers who have passed on to the Omega Charge. With Bro. Rev. William Harter, Iota Deuteron (Williams) '58 presiding over the service, we were once again blessed with an amazing musical experience as we remembered those who came before us. Thursday evening, we once again met at the Charge House to cookout and kick back as the Convention itself felt like a local Charge event. Our hosts at Sigma Deuteron certainly outdid themselves with their hospitality and the house itself was certainly a Theta Delta Chi residence to be proud of.

Friday's Business Session saw the election of the 133rd Grand Lodge

of Theta Delta Chi with the 62nd President of the Grand Lodge Adam McCready, Chi Deuteron (George Washington) '02 being re-elected to a second two-year term. Joining Bro. McCready and GTGL George Henry Aulson IV, Iota Triton (UMass-Dartmouth) '08 are newly elected Secretary of the Grand Lodge Matthew Cortland, Lambda Triton (Rutgers) '11, Treasurer of the Grand Lodge, Max Wendkos, Sigma Triton (Penn State) '10 and Graduate Secretary of the Grand Lodge, Lance Lochner, Sigma Deuteron (Wisconsin) '09, who continues his service after a one year term as TGL. In addition, Bro. Kyle O'Keefe, Upsilon Deuteron (Wabash) '09 and Bro. Jacob Dababneh, Lambda Deuteron (Toronto) '03 were elected to one-year directorships on the Theta Delta Chi Educational Foundation.

That evening, the Convention took in an Independent League baseball game between the Madison Mallards and the Eau Claire Express. It was quite the jubilant affair as many of our

brothers participated in-between inning relay races and we watched our 'hometown' Mallards stage a miraculous come-from-behind victory. For many, this event proved to be one of the highlights of the 162nd Convention.

On Saturday morning, the convention gathered to hear the story of Patrick Kuhse, Epsilon Triton (Arizona State) '76, who told how poor decision making led to his incarceration for white-collar crime and how the values of Theta Delta Chi and the support of his family and brothers helped him to regain control of his life. It was an amazing experience for all of our members to hear such a riveting first-hand account of the importance of staying true to one's values. In the afternoon, as the Theta Delta Chi Educational Foundation held its annual meeting, the undergraduate members collaborated through various roundtables on different ways to strengthen and improve their Charges and Colonies.

The Convention culminated

with the Grand Banquet at the Wisconsin Union in a gorgeous ballroom overlooking Lake Mendota on Saturday evening. With nearly 120 attendees and a fantastic meal, it was the perfect end to a great week. Bro. Jeff Horton, Nu Triton (Virginia Tech) '90 was our host for the awards ceremony which, among other awards, recognized the Xi Deuteron Charge at the University of Washington with this year's Victory Cup, annually awarded to Theta Delta Chi's best overall Charge and Bro. C. Philip Curley, Kappa Triton (Northwestern) '76 as the 2009 Theta Delt of the Year. This year's banquet was markedly energetic which matched the overall positive and jubilant tone of the 162nd Convention. When all was said and done, the week had flown by and many were reluctant to say goodbye to Madison and the Sigma Deuteron Charge. Thankfully, we can look forward to seeing many familiar faces next year at the 163rd Convention in Washington, DC to once again renew in union our social joys.
