How Are You Staying Connected?






Session times for undergraduate delegates are planned to be:

Now is the time to apply for a scholarship from the Educational Foundation. The deadline for submitting all application materials is June 15. Paper applications can be found <u>here</u> and electronic applications with full instructions are at <u>tdxscholars.org</u>.

Scholarships range anywhere from \$1000 to \$4000. There are two named scholarships, the Porter Scholarship for \$1000 given to a candidate excelling in chemistry or another science and several Davenport Scholarships in the amount of \$4000. In addition to the two named scholarships, there are several other general awards in varying amounts between \$1000 and \$2000.

Charge Awards!!!



Abel Beach graduated from Union College in 1849 and taught Latin and Greek at the University of Iowa. He also was a business partner in a stationary company and a published poet. His book,

Western Airs: Choice Selections From the Miscellaneous Poems is still <u>available for purchase</u>. His poem, "Old Settlers of Johnson County", appears in the <u>lowa Historical Record</u> volumes 7-9 pages 44-47. Later in life, Brother Beach was admitted to the bar, and became a successful insurance and pension attorney. He died in Iowa City in 1899.
