

PGL Letter

First, let me say how humbled I am to become the 62nd President of the Grand Lodge. I follow the lead of many great Theta Delts that have served in this capacity, and I am dedicated to preserving the values and integrity of our organization. I do not take this responsibility lightly, and I look forward to aiding the development of men that improve themselves intellectually, morally, and socially through friendship.

Being from New Hampshire, I recently had the opportunity to execute one of my unalienable rights as a United States citizen: the right to vote. My walk to the polling station allowed me to think not only about our rights as citizens, but also about our rights and privileges as members of our beloved fraternity. For example, each active Charge has the right to have two undergraduate and one graduate delegate vote at our annual conventions. Like the rights of citizenship, our rights and privileges as Thetes are often taken for granted and not brought to fruition (e.g., only a handful of active Charges fielded full delegations to Convention).

With this premise in mind, I challenge all Theta Delts to get the most out of their fraternal experiences, and to execute their powers as members of Theta Delta Chi. We all want the same thing from our fraternity. It was 17th President of the Grand Lodge Carl Harstrom, Xi 1886,



I believe, who said it best during his remarks at an 1897 banquet honoring then Ambassador to England John Hay, Zeta 1858: "We want our fraternity to be a potent factor for good: we want it to

stand for friendship that

endures through thick and thin." These words still ring true 111 years later, and will ring true for 111more.

Yet how can you help Theta Delta Chi be a "potent factor for good"?

For our undergraduates, I challenge you to recruit men of good character, men that aim to improve themselves intellectually, morally, and socially through friendship. It only takes one brother to recruit a new member, and I am confident you can name that one brother who introduced you to Theta Delta Chi (thank you Mike Donaldson, Chi Deuteron '01). If you recruit men of sound character, our Charges will continue to be potent factors of good for years to come.

For our alumni, Theta Delta Chi is ripe with opportunities for involvement and innovation. The majority of our Charges are in need of alumni advisors and support. Rusty Parker, a chapter advisor for Beta Theta Pi Fraternity at Auburn University said, "There is a critical need for young men to have older men take a genuine interest in their growth." With Theta Delta Chi in an exciting period of growth and renewal, chances are that there is a Charge in your own backyard in need of assistance.

Also, are you involved with a Charge or area alumni association? If not, could you take time from your schedule to help develop one? With often thousands of our alumni living in close proximity to one another (e.g., Boston, New York), could you play a role in organizing an alumni association that helps "friendship endure through thick and thin"?

The fraternity is also expanding our programming base for our members. In 2007 the inaugural leadership academy, the Preamble Institute, was an immense success; the program will return in April 2008. By giving to the Theta Delta Chi Educational Foundation, you can assure programs like the Preamble Institute, ones that promote the values of Theta Delta Chi, will continue for years to come.

Much like the United States or Canada, our principles and values only survive through the execution of our rights and privileges as brothers of Theta Delta Chi. Take advantage of these opportunities, and help our beloved fraternity be perpetuated through all future generations.

The Old and the Nu Convention 2007

The 160th CONVENTION of our beloved fraternity took place August 8-11th and saw a multitude of brothers converge on lovely Charlottesville, Virginia. The long weekend celebrated the 150th anniversary of the chartering of the Nu Charge and was a testament to the longevity of the fraternity and the dedication of this great body of alumni. In addition, over 60 undergraduate brothers from 22 Charges and one Colony participated in the Convention in a variety of events.

The majority of the Convention attendees stayed at the beautiful Omni Hotel in downtown Charlottesville, right next to a plethora of shops

and restaurants. The first evening, many alumni and undergraduates broke the ice with an appetizer reception at the South Street Brewery, a few blocks from the hotel before going out for a night of revelry on the town. The Thursday and Friday business sessions ran smoothly with Bro. Adam McCready, Chi Deuteron '02, a former Charge Consultant, being elected

President of the 131st Grand Lodge. Other new members of the Grand Lodge include Brian Bertges, Sigma Triton '00, as Graduate Secretary and Josh Sowell, Gamma Triton '09 (Michigan State) and George Henry Aulson IV, Iota Triton '08 (UMass-Dartmouth) as the Treasurer and Secretary respectively. Graduate Treasurer Jerome Arnold, Xi Deuteron '00 (Washington), will complete the two-year term to which he was elected in 2006.

Thursday evening saw many great events including a group picture at the Rotunda of the University of Virginia, the traditional Omega Service at the University Chapel honoring brothers who passed away in the previous year, and a wonderful reception at the Nu Charge house. The Nu alumni, wives and undergraduates hosted the barbecue with fantastic food and showed off their newly renovated house. It definitely showed that that Charge would be around for another 150 years!

Saturday kicked off with a fantastic morning tour of Thomas Jefferson's home at Monticello. About 100 undergraduates and alumni spent about four hours visiting the estate before returning to the Omni for lunch. We were blessed with perfect weather for the morning and everyone enjoyed the snapshot of colonial life.

After lunch the undergraduates participated in CampusSpeak's Recruitment Boot camp sponsored by the Theta Delta Chi Educational Foundation. The program taught our members

to better recruit members. The program also gave them tangible methods for increasing the size and quality of their Charges.

The Grand Banquet on Saturday evening was truly 'Grand' in every way. In addition, to being one of the largest banquets in the last few years with over 160 guests, it took place at the famous Boars Head Inn. There was a wonderful spirit in the air as we once again celebrated the 150 years of the Nu Charge as well as formally presented the charter for our newest group, Theta Triton at Binghamton University. The awards ceremony recognized many individuals for their service to the fraternity and many Charges for their successful years. Nu Alumni Peter Hoyt '63 and Mike Perfater '69 took top honor as Theta Delts of the Year for their service to Nu. Howard Cosgrove, Nu '65 was also recognized with the Theta Delta Chi Achievement Award for his long career in business and public service.

The Alumni of the Year awards were given to Bob Ferguson, Eta Deuteron '46 (Stanford) for his service to his Charge and Jacob Dababneh, Lambda Deuteron '03 (Toronto), for his work with both his own charge and the Epsilon Triton Colony. Three men were recognized as Undergraduates of the Year: Brian Kohn and Trevor Johnson from Nu and Jeff Blake from Lambda Deuteron.

The Charge awards were very competitive this year with **Iota Triton** (UMass-Dartmouth) claiming top honors with the Victory Cup for Charge of the Year **Sigma Deuteron** (Wisconsin) won Most Improved, Xi Deuteron (Washington) won the Presidents Cup for strongest ritual and Delta Deuteron (Cal-Berkeley) won the Ritual Improvement Cup. > Charge, Theta Triton (Binghamton) won the inaugural Robert N. LoParo Community Service and Philanthropy Cup named for outgoing PGL Bob LoParo to commemorate his eight years of service on the Grand Lodge. The award will bear his name for the next eight years until the 2015 Convention.

All told, the 160th Convention was an amazing time. Brothers from all over the country converged to tell stories of the past and look to the future. In addition to the large contingent of brothers from the Nu Charge, we also had many alumni from Charges around the country with only a few groups unrepresented.

Next year's Convention in Las Vegas looks to be even bigger, as only a city like that could provide. We look forward to seeing everyone again when we all reunite next year for the 161st Convention of our beloved Fraternity.

ith this issue of *The Shield* we kick off the 2008 Voluntary Graduate Dues campaign. The calendar campaign for 2007 was a great success, thanks to our loyal and generous alumni listed in the Honor Roll of Giving. Sincere thanks to these men who have enjoyed a lifelong "friendship founded on mutual esteem and dependence" for their commitment and enduring loyalty and support.

The concept behind VG Dues is simple. Alumni support insures that our fraternity has a future. Without that support, the Educational Foundation could not fulfill its mission to meet the needs of our undergraduate brothers. The primary beneficiaries of the Educational Foundation's programs are members of the fraternity, and by extension, the local campus communities. Alumni support enables the Foundation to realize its mission to promote education and brotherhood for each new generation of undergraduate Theta Delts, affording them the opportunity to enjoy the rewards and pleasures of fraternity membership.

Alumni generosity and support has enabled us to hire excellent Charge Consultants. These young alumni educate, troubleshoot, help with rush, teach our rituals, train undergraduate officers, nurture new Charges and seek and mentor interest groups in schools where Theta Delta Chi was once active. The Charge Consultants' efforts have been richly rewarded this year:

- Theta Triton at the University of Binghamton was chartered last April, the first completely new Charge since Iota Triton (U Mass—Dartmouth) in 2005.
- Our Colony at the University of South Carolina has been approved for chartering by the Grand Lodge and the Charges, and by March 1st will revive the long-lost Rho Proteron Charge, inactive since 1859!
- Officially recognized Colonies at Arizona State University (Epsilon Triton), Marist College (Tau Triton) and Rutgers (Lambda Triton) all expect to petition for charters in 2008.
- We have a Colony of 40 men at the University of Michigan intent on rebuilding Gamma Deuteron, which has been inactive since 1996.
- Xi at Hobart will be recolonized this spring after 11 years in the wilderness and Psi Deuteron at UCLA will be recolonized next fall after five years' absence.
- An interest group at Old Dominion University in Virginia is seeking recognition.

Given the incredible success this past year, our tireless Central Fraternity staff and volunteers hope to continue establishing new charges and more importantly revive some of our inactive charges such as Phi (Lafayette), Nu Deuteron (Lehigh), Kappa Deuteron (Illinois), Mu (UNC Chapel Hill) and Psi Triton (Santa Barbara).

Rho Proteron is Newest Charge

The Active Charges have unanimously approved the addition of RHO PROTERON to the ranks of Theta Delta Chi. Investiture of the UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH CAROLINA group will take place at the Columbia campus at the end of February, with a chartering banquet in Charleston on March 1 to coincide with Midwinter Meetings of the Grand Lodge, Founders' Corporation, and Educational Foundation. Contact the CFO for more information if you are interested in attending.

Founded in 1859, Rho Charge seems to have existed only one year. All records probably disappeared when the city of Columbia was burned by General Sherman early in 1865. The Grand Lodge later transferred the Greek letter to the Charge at Washington and Lee University in Virginia, designating the USC Charge as Rho "Proteron," i.e. "first" in Greek. Early Catalogues of the Fraternity acknowledge that there is no record of any members.

Last year's Grand Lodge decided that maintaining the "Proteron" rather than assigning an entirely new Charge designation, or reviving "Rho" alone and thus causing potential confusion with Washington & Lee (although that Charge went inactive in 1872), would strengthen the historical connection between the present group and their distant forebears.

The Rho Pro's, as they are sometimes informally called, have made pilgrimages to the grave of Samuel F. Wile in nearby Pineville. Wile is the only Founder buried in South Carolina.

Both served on the cabinet of President William McKinley. Also, Bro. Daniel Lockwood, Alpha 1869, served as the General Manager of the Pan American Exposition in 1901, site of McKinley's assassination.
