

REVOCATION OF LAMBDA TRITON CHARTER

As a result of multiple Risk Management Violations of Rutgers University and Theta Delta Chi Policy, the Lambda Triton Charge has been placed on a five-year loss of recognition by the University. At a special meeting of the Grand Lodge on September 3, 2021 the charter of Lambda Triton Charge has been revoked and they are no long able to operate as a Charge of Theta Delta Chi. This was not an easy decision to make; however, a necessary one given the health and safety implications for the entire University community and the reputation of Theta Delta Chi.

first Zeel service, Massage On-Demand®, and its associated iOS and Android apps, was launched in the greater New York City area on April 2, 2013 and expanded to the San Francisco Bay Area, Los Angeles Metropolitan Area and South Florida on August 29, 2014.

Brother Hamadeh sits on the board of the non-profit <u>PeaceWorks Foundation</u> and is or has been a board observer, angel investor and advisor in two dozen early-stage companies, including Directly, <u>Campusfood.com</u> (sold to GrubHub Seamless), Crunched, Splurgy, and <u>PublicStuff</u> (now part of Accela). Samer is also a mentor at several accelerators, Blueprint Health, NYCSeedStart, and First Growth Venture Network, as well as a member of <u>Young Presidents' Organization</u> and the Executive Board of <u>Venture for America</u>.

In addition to all of this, Samer is a David Rockefeller Fellow, and an entrepreneur in residence with Lightspeed Venture Partners. He also finds time to devote time, energy and talent to current efforts to assist Eta Deuteron Charge. He is an excellent example of what is the best of being a Theta Delt.
